RE: Fundraising Events

On **Wednesday 19th December 2018**, we will be having a fundraiser to raise money for the Centrepont Homeless Charity who support homeless young people aged 16-25. This includes a non-uniform day, face painting, bake sale, and a winter music concert.

We will be having a non-school uniform day, asking all students who dress in non-school uniform to donate a minimum of £2 or a discounted price of £1 for students wearing a Christmas Jumper. Below are our expectations regarding the dress code. Meeting these expectations will be supported by the school behaviour system.

- Hoods are allowed but must be kept down/off whilst in school. No hats/caps allowed.
- Own bags are allowed but all equipment must be brought in and should fit in your bag.
- Pupils are NOT allowed to wear jewellery or make-up.
- No ripped clothing is allowed (jeans etc...).
- No clothing which is revealing.
- Offensive images/language will not be tolerated.

Donations for non-uniform will be collected at the gate. Students who do not wish to participate must attend school in full academy uniform.

During break time and lunch time the school council will run a **bake sale** from the vibe café. We strongly welcome all students to bring in cakes/treats which can either be home-made or shop bought. Note that Phoenix Academy is a nut-free school therefore please be mindful when adding your ingredients (or checking the packaging). We will also have a gluten free/dairy free stand!

The **winter music concert** will also take place in the theatre between **3.45pm and 4.30pm** and will see many of our students showcase their musical talents to the rest of the school. Tickets are limited and are available for both students and parents/carers from Ms Ugono. If you would like to attend, please ask your child to collect a ticket on your behalf. Donations for the Centrepont Homeless Charity are also welcomed at this event.
